Committees

The School Board may create separate Board committees as deemed necessary. The Board President will make all Board committee appointments and designate a chairperson for each committee, subject to Board approval. The President will be an ex-officio member and the Superintendent will be a non-voting member of all Board committees.

Notice of Board committee meetings will be given in the same manner as notice of regular and special meetings, all of which will be open to the public. The committee chairperson is responsible for notifying all committee members of the time and date of any meeting. Minutes of these meetings will be kept and approved at regular Board meetings.

Board committees will report directly to the Board.
