**Consultants to the Board**

When appropriate or necessary, the Board may retain the services of professional consultants in an advisory or evaluative capacity.

Professional consultants such as the Board attorney, architect and auditor must possess appropriate professional training and experience, as determined by the Board. They must be properly licensed to perform the particular professional service and be members in good standing of such professional organizations as are customary for practitioners in their field.

Prior to employment, consultant candidates may be required to submit a "proposal for services." Also, such candidates must advise the Superintendent.

All professional consultants hired by the Board will immediately advise the Superintendent of any disciplinary proceedings instituted against them in connection with their professional activities, whether brought by a licensing agency or professional organization. The Board will determine whether such proceedings will undermine the confidence the Board must have in the consultant.
