Organizational Board Meetings

The Board will meet to organize within 28 days after the consolidated election. Upon organizing itself, the Board will begin discharging its duties.

To facilitate the organizational meeting, the Board will take the following actions at a regular meeting during the month prior to the organizational meeting:

1. Establish a date for the organizational meeting.
2. Designate a president pro tempore, who will convene the organizational meeting, appoint a temporary secretary, and conduct the election of the Board President. The new Board President will conduct the election of the Board Vice President and Secretary.

At the organizational meeting, the following will occur:

1. Any new Board members will be immediately seated.
2. The Board will elect its officers, who assume office immediately upon being elected.
