Administration in Absence of Policy

From time to time, events will occur in the District where an officially adopted policy will not be present to serve as an administrative guide. When no applicable policy exists, the Superintendent is authorized to act in what he/she thinks to be in the best interests of the District. The Superintendent will consider the welfare of the District, the professional code of ethics, and past practice, prior to taking any action.

The Superintendent is responsible for notifying the Board when he/she must act outside of adopted policies and for recommending--when appropriate--any policies that may be needed to cover future recurrences. His/her decisions will be subject to review by the Board at its next meeting.
