Succession of Authority

If the Superintendent is absent for an extraordinary length of time, the School Board President will call a Board meeting to appoint, if necessary, an interim superintendent.

If a Central Office administrator is absent for an extended period of time, the Superintendent may appoint an interim administrator. If a building principal is absent due to an extended illness or leave of absence, the Superintendent may assign an assistant principal or other certified administrator as acting principal for a period not to exceed 60 school days. The Board will be kept advised and must approve all interim replacements.
