Succession of Authority

If the Superintendent, Building Principal, or other administrator is temporarily unavailable, the succession of authority and responsibility of the respective office shall follow a succession plan, developed by the Superintendent. If the Superintendent is absent for an extraordinary length of time, the School Board President will call a Board meeting to appoint, if necessary, an interim superintendent.
