Electronic Media Publication

District 204 utilizes electronic media including, but not limited to the Internet, television, and radio. Such media may be used to communicate with teachers, students and the community at large to produce, display, and/or distribute relevant information about district/school curricular programs or other district related business. As electronic media is being used for educational purposes related to the curriculum or other school-related businesses of the district, it is not a public forum for free speech, or a right of students or staff.

All electronic media publications must comply with provisions in policies 6:235 (Access to Electronic Networks) and 7:310 (Restrictions on Publications).

Also, such information must also have the prior approval of the appropriate school principal/administrator and contain no commercial advertising. The Superintendent's designee(s) will serve as the publisher(s) of electronic media and will have final editorial authority with respect to all of the district's electronic media publications.
