### **Reassignment to Different Attendance Center**

Under the School Code and Board Policy 7:30 (*Student Assignment and Intra-District Transfer*), students are assigned to attendance centers as determined necessary by the Board of Education and Administration. Students may be reassigned to a different attendance center.

Regardless of the location of the conduct, a student who has been charged, convicted, plead guilty or determined delinquent, in a court of law in connection with a violent felony against another student assigned to the same attendance may be assigned to another school within the District for a period of time determined by the Administration on a case-by-case basis, if the Administration finds that the interests of any student or the school warrant such reassignment.

Prior to the implementation of any involuntary reassignment under this policy, the Superintendent or his/her designee will meet with the parents/guardians of the students involved and provide information concerning (1) options which are legally available to the District; (2) counseling or other interventions which may be available to any involved students from District or third-party sources; (3) evaluation of the needs of any student which may be necessary or appropriate to determine a course of action; and (4) opportunities for mediation or other dispute resolution.

A student may be transferred to a non-district alternative school in circumstances permitted or authorized by law.

The duration of a transfer to another school within the District or a non-district alternative school will be determined on a case-by-case basis by the administration.

For students who have been identified as disabled under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, 20 U.S.C. 1400, et seq., any such transfer is subject to, and will be implemented in accordance with, the requirements of the IDEA, Article 14 of the Illinois School Code, and applicable state and federal regulations.

The Superintendent shall inform the Board within 72 hours of any incident or circumstances which, in his/her opinion, may warrant a student(s) reassignment under this Policy.
